March and April Considerations:

- Be sure your IRS Form 990N has been submitted.
- Appoint your nominating committee and set your Club Annual Meeting to occur by the end of the 2nd week in May.
- Make your Annual Club Gift of \$5.00 per member to the Kiwanis International Foundation if you haven't already done this.
- Personally contact members who have not been attending your meetings.
- Send your contribution of \$2.00 per member to Division 5. Make your check payable to Kiwanis Div. 5 and send to Ralph Harness, 4504 Crestfield Rd, Knoxville, TN 37921.
- Consider and plan a membership drive or membership growth function.
- Review progress toward being a Distinguished Club this year.
- Don't forget 1st Lady Betty's Diversity in Reading project.
- Elect, and report to Kiwanis International by April 30, two delegates and two alternates to represent your club at the International Convention.
- Set your Annual Club meeting date and appoint your nominating committee.

GUIDELINES FOR NOMINATION

Kentucky Tennessee District of Kiwanis International Division 5 2008 LAYPERSON OF THE YEAR AWARD

Each club in good standing within Division 5 Kentucky Tennessee District of Kiwanis International is encouraged to nominate a member in good standing of their club for the Layperson of the Year Award.

The Layperson of the Year Award recognizes an individual Kiwanian who exemplifies the first two Objects of Kiwanis International, namely

- To give primacy to the human and spiritual, rather than to the material values of life.
- To encourage the daily living of the Golden Rule in all human relationships.

A nomination is to include a written narrative, not more than two pages (500 words) in length, plus the signed cover sheet. The narrative should highlight the nominee's actions over the past year, April 1, 2007 to March 31, 2008. Longevity is NOT the key ingredient in the nominee's record of service to mankind for the purpose of this award. Younger members of Kiwanis have an equal opportunity of being nominated and selected for this award.

The nomination must be signed by (1) Club President, (2) Chair of Human and Spiritual Values Committee, and (3) Club Secretary.

The selection of the Division 5 Layperson of the Year will be based on the above material addressed to Asa O. Bishop, Jr. at the address below and postmarked on or before Monday, April 30, 2008. No other submissions will be accepted, and to be considered, all submissions MUST meet all of the above criteria.
